



Ontario's Only Food & Film Festival returns to Toronto for a fourth year

Toronto Food Film Fest 2022 looks to celebrate independent film-making, food and culture with screenings, workshops and curated menus

TORONTO -- June 13, 2022 -- The Toronto Food Film Fest (TFFF), Ontario's only food film festival is back for its 4th iteration with a four-day action packed schedule taking place from October 14th to 17th.

TFFF is back at The Royal Theatre on College Street this year, where it will once again bring together food and film lovers across Toronto by combining in-person screenings, workshops, dinners, tastings and more. [Bottega Volo](#), now in the Royal Cinemas lobby, will be supplying concessions and chefs will be serving the audience carefully selected snacks that pair with each movie.

"We're so excited to be back for a fourth year, and looking forward to being back at the Royal Cinema, one of the few remaining historic independent cinemas in the GTA. College Street is also arguably one of Toronto's liveliest food streets." says Jacqueline Tam, Co-Founder of TFFF. "The quality of film submissions already received is better than ever so our selection is difficult."

Film submissions have been extended until June 24th and a full film lineup and programming schedule will be released later this summer. The Toronto Food Film Fest is honored to have the support of [Telefilm](#) and the [Toronto Arts Council](#). [Rolling Pictures](#) and [Sim](#) are also back and sponsoring award categories "People's Choice Award" and "Best Cinematography Award", respectively. The festival will continue to be accessible online through virtual tickets available across Ontario.

"TFFF continues to try to bring people together through food and film," says Tam. "Promoting independent films continues to be an important priority, especially being able to pair that with Toronto's diverse and growing food scene. We are eager to bring attendees a new lineup of films, food demonstrations, dinners, talks, tastings, and the crowd favourite film and snack pairings." This immersive programming will be available through individual tickets as well as a limited number of VIP passes. "We can't wait to welcome everyone back!"
